

## Berezan. Business letter

**Description:** private letter written on one side of a lead sheet found rolled in a tube; the address is engraved in the sheet's obverse side (dimensions: h:6.5 w:15.0)

**Layout:** the writing is left to right

**Letters:** Milesian alphabet

**Origin:** Berezan (Black Sea area)

**Dating:** ca. 500 BC (dated on letters form)

**Findspot:** Berezan (from the excavations of 1970)

**Current location:** St. Peterburg, The State Hermitage Museum (inv. 8.70. 322)
